### Sculpture Workshops

10am - 11:30am and 12:30pm - 2pm

Students will participate in a practical workshop devised and delivered by one of our Education Program Artists, exploring materials and ideas to create their own sculptural artworks. Activities are varied and will be based on the Artist's work in the exhibition. Cost: \$300.

### Artist Spotlight Talks

10:30am - 11:30am and 1pm - 2pm

Students will meet and engage with an exhibiting artist, discussing their work and artistic practice. Students will be encouraged to examine the artist's work in the context of the exhibition through interactive dialogue, exploring themes, materials and techniques. Q&A opportunities make this an ideal case study activity for senior classes. Cost: \$160.

### Focus Tours

10:30am - 12pm and 1pm - 2:30pm

Students will gain a comprehensive overview of the exhibition and engage with a selection of sculptures on site. Tours may vary in format from 60min intensives to 90min sessions with a practical component, and tour content can now be tailored to suit individual class objectives. Teachers may select one of the following *Focus* areas:

- *Introduction to Sculpture*
- *Targeting the Contemporary*
- *Artists' Practice*

Cost: 60min Tour - \$100 per Group;  
90min Tour\* - \$120 per Group
